My dear Mrs. Adams:

For the Librarian, I am writing to acknowledge your letter of March 8, in which you request his aid in order to complete some researches in your study of "the evolution of the economy and politics of the Soviet Union".

According to a report from Mr. Gooch, the Superintendent of the Reading Rooms, to whom the matter was submitted, your application for the privilege of withdrawing books was received at a time of considerable pressure in his office. Scores of applications for the renewal of privileges previously granted were under consideration with a view to reducing the number of borrowers whose needs were not consistent with the purpose of this service. We are sorry that the pressure of work has resulted in this inconvenience to you, but I am sure you will realize the necessity of an adequate statement of the purpose of an investigation before any borrowing privileges can be extended, particularly in the present emergency.

To facilitate your work, we now enclose a card permitting you to draw from the Library books, including Russian books, needed in your researches, so far as capable of issue. The card reads until June 30, 1942, but, should the need continue, it will be renewed thereafter upon request.
