Togliatti Stresses Independent CPs

ROME, June 17.—Italy's Communist Party Secretary Palmiro Togliatti criticized Soviet Communist Party leader, Nikita Khrushchev and stressed the national paths to Socialism.

He said it was all very well for the Soviet leaders to criticize Stalin. But he said what is needed is their explanation based on Marxist criteria of how such errors "got mixed up with the development of a socialist society."

"The question of the responsibility of the entire directing group must be considered," he said. "This includes those comrades who today have taken the initiative in denouncing the errors of Stalin and their consequences.

"I exclude the explanation that it was impossible to change things because of the presence of a military and police force which kept control of the situation with methods of terror.

"The error of Stalin's collaborators lay in not seeing that they had let him do as he wished until

it was too late to make a change."

The Soviet Union remains the "first great model of the construction of a Socialist society," Togliatti said, but "the front of Socialist contruction has broadened. The Soviet mode cannot and must not be obligatory any more."

"The internal political structure of the World Communist movement is changing today," he de-
