Dear Comrades of the OCIC,

With this letter the NSC's Local Center Task Force would like to report to you on its progress and the forward movement around the country in establishing local and regional OCIC Centers.

Task Force Report

1. We would like to remind everyone that the completion of the questions in the Local Center Post Conference Packet are due March 1st. It is important that all comrades meet this deadline. If you are an organization or Center, all minority and majority positions must be fully explained. To date, the Task Force has received one response.
2. Local Centers in Southern California, Minneapolis and Detroit are presently in the process of writing full summaries of the history of their local centers. These summaries will be very helpful to the rest of the country, and will be shared as soon as they are ready through the Task Force. There are other Local Centers established that should also take on this task in the near future.
3. The Task Force is still in the process of preparing a Bulletin for internal use giving helpful suggestions and guidelines on how to build a Local Center. Hopefully, it will be out to the OCIC by mid March.
