INTRODUCTION: An excellent situation prevails in the world and in Britain today. We have entered the stage in world history where the principal contradiction in the world between the people of the world - including the people in the imperialist heartlands - and the two superpowers, the United States and the Soviet Union, and their hangers-on, is on the verge of being resolved. The Third World, led by Socialist China and the great, glorious and correct Communist Party of China and beloved Chairman Mao, is the main force in the greatest offensive that mankind has ever launched to storm heaven to usher in THE NEW WORLD of socialism and communism. Victory of world people's revolution and the establishment of the INTERNATIONAL DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT, with the People's Liberation Army of China as the main pillar, are indeed the order of the day.

The fascist bourgeoisie of Britain and their fascist state -- an integral part of NATO, the international dictatorship of the bourgeoisie led by the United States -- are caught in their final death-throes. Every economic indicator in Britain glaringly reveals this fact. Production is declining (steel, machine-building, auto, housing etc). Bankruptcies reached the record figure of 7,500 last year; of these the number of corporations that have gone bust are the highest in 60 years. Being an imperialist economy which is dependent on the outside world, particularly the Third World, for 80% of its industrial raw materials and 50% of its food, it is not surprising that the trade deficits of Britain keep on accumulating. With nearly 120 countries, mainly of the Third World, led by Socialist China, fighting for a new international economic order, the capacity of the British imperialists to push their burden on to the oppressed nations of Asia, Africa and Latin America is severely restricted. Fighting like grim death to salvage their profits, the fascist bourgeoisie are shifting their burden on to the working people of Britain. The value of the pound is nose-diving; inflation is sky-rocketing. The real income of the working people is decreasing with each passing day. As some workers put it: the pound will soon have the worth of the toilet paper because today even potatoes are becoming "a luxury good"! Unemployment is increasing. Public expenditure cuts (hospitals, schools, colleges, etc.) are beginning to bite as never before. The increasing impoverishment of the working people in Britain is fuelling their indomitable fighting spirit. They are resorting to various forms of struggle to prevent the monopoly capitalists from shifting the burden of the crises on to them: strikes, especially unofficial ones; occupations; demonstrations, rallies and meetings of various kinds to voice their indignation and denounce the fascist bourgeoisie are mounting. In February alone there were 165 strikes. In March, thousands of workers participated in a 200-mile "March against unemployment" from Birmingham to London. May Day demonstrations, rallies and meetings throughout the country showed yet again the wrath of the working people. In recent weeks the student teachers have risen up to occupy their colleges in protest against unemployment. All these manifestations of the revolutionary mass movement in Britain show as Chairman Mao says: "poverty gives rise to the desire for change, the desire for action, the desire for revolution."

In its frenzied attempts to restrain the wrath of the working people of Britain the fascist state is forced to reveal more and more its terrorist nature. Detention of various militants under the pretext of "preventing terrorism" and fostering openly fascist organisations to try to divert the rest in now undertaken. But the bourgeoisie of Britain have long ago realised that their dirty work can best be performed by their agents within the working-class movement, donning various kinds of "progressive" cloaks: the revisionists, the trotskyites, other social democrats and trade union scabs. All of these crooks and scoundrels vie with one another to keep the struggles of the workers and student youth at the spontaneous level. Underestimating the revolutionary capacity of the people, they consistently cultivate among the wrathful masses reliance on the sensibleness of the bourgeoisie. Without exception they uphold the authority of bourgeois legalism - the fascist courts, the out-dated Parliament, etc. They try to confine the workers to the narrow confines of the bankrupt trade union system, a defensive weapon of the fascist bourgeoisie. Thus their "revolution" is to be with the permission of the bourgeoisie. Their hatred for the invincible ideology of the working-class - Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tsetung Thought - is shown in their unity in practice, whatever their differences in words, to keep out of the growing consciousness of the British people the historic victories scored in China and the world by the PROLETARIAN REVOLUTIONARY LINE OF CHAIRMAN MAO. In this criminal work, the revisionists who wave the banner of Chairman Mao are the most pernicious. Using metaphysics and eclectics they refuse to integrate with the working people and arm them with the optimistic perspective of the impending victory of world revolution whether there is war or not.

From February 1st this year, the Party Committee of the Workers' Institute which upholds the leadership of the C.C. of the Communist Party of China and Chairman Mao, taking class struggle as the key link and applying in practice our Chairman's (cont'd pg. 8) Printed herein are excerpts from publicity leaflets for meetings organised by the Institute in and around Brixton. -- Editor.

(1) "COMMUNIST PARTY OF ENGLAND (MARXIST-LENINIST)" AND OTHERS WHO WAVE THE BANNER OF CHAIRMAN MAO TO ATTACK CHAIRMAN MAO'S FORCES

From February 1st this year, the British fascist state, not satisfied with the continuous harrassment of the Communists in the Workers' Institute of Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tsetung Thought since its birth in 1974, began to mount frenzied and wild attacks against our organisation by arresting five of our members -- Comrades Ara Balakrishnan, Wee Hock Seng, Ekins Brome, Najeeb Norman and Frank Murray -- on trumped-up charges. Four of these comrades are members of our Party Committee which upholds the leadership of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China and Chairman Mao. Comrade Balakrishnan, the Secretary of the Party Committee who was arrested for the fifth time since 1971, was detained for 54 days. Comrade Ekins Brome, who was arrested for the third time, has been sentenced to one year in jail. All our comrades as soldiers of Chairman Mao and servants of the people uphold the communist spirit of self-sacrifice and Chairman Mao's proletarian revolutionary line. They refused to recognise the authority of the bourgeois courts and resolutely denounced them as a tool of the dictatorship of the fascist bourgeoisie of Britain. They have heroically resisted numerous assaults made on them by the fascist police and prison wardens, driving the fascist bourgeoisie into total panic. The members and supporters of the Workers' Institute have steeled themselves further through this acute and violent class struggle and are stepping up the work of building the revolutionary mass movement to expose and denounce the political persecution of our comrades by the British fascist state which attempts to terrorize and restrain the revolutionary masses under the guise of combating terrorism and upholding "democratic rights".

Chairman Mao has pointed out that "historically, all reactionary forces on the verge of extinction invariably conduct a last desperate struggle against the revolutionary forces, and some revolutionaries are apt to be deluded for a time by this phenomenon of outward strength but inner weakness, failing to grasp the essential fact that the enemy is nearing extinction while they themselves are approaching victory." He has also said: "I hold that it is bad as far as we are concerned if a person, a political party, an army or a school is not attacked by the enemy, for in that case it would definitely mean that we have sunk to the level of the enemy. It is good if we are attacked by the enemy, since it proves that we have drawn a clear line of demarcation between the enemy and ourselves. It is still better if the enemy attacks us wildly and paints us as utterly black and without a single virtue; it demonstrates that we have not only drawn a clear line of demarcation between the enemy and ourselves but achieved a great deal in our work."

Ever since its birth the Workers' Institute has pointed out that the world is now in an entirely new stage -- an excellent stage in which the main enemies of mankind, the two hegemonic superpowers, the United States and the Soviet Union are in their final death-throes, are extremely isolated and are on the verge of being attacked by the people of the world, in particular the people of the Third World, led by Socialist China. Victory of world people's revolution and the establishment of the INTERNATIONAL DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT are the order of the day -- the old world of colonialism, imperialism and hegemonism is in its last days and THE NEW WORLD of socialism is being born so that mankind can march onward to communism. For the achievement of this unprecedented event in world history, the working and oppressed people of the world have the three magic weapons: the great, glorious and correct Communist Party of China led by beloved Chairman Mao, the heroic People's Liberation Army of China, the proletarian internationalist army under the leadership of our Party and the international united front of the people of the world, including the people in the imperialist and social-imperialist countries, led by our Party against the two superpowers and their hangers-on. It is on the basis of this correct line and optimistic perspective that the Party Committee of the Workers' Institute has stepped up its work in Britain, in particular the work of building a stable base area in and around Brixton. It is the victorious development of this work that has driven the British fascist state -- an integral part of NATO led by the hegemonic superpower, the United States -- into total frenzy resulting in the recent spate of wild attacks against the Workers' Institute cadres, the soldiers of Chairman Mao in the imperialist heartlands.

In carrying out the crimes against the forces of Chairman Mao in the Workers' Institute, the British fascist state is aided and abetted by their agents within the working-class movement -- the revisionists, the trotskyites and trade union scabs. Of these the revisionists in the so-called Marxist-Leninist circles in Britain are the most devious. They wave the red flag to attack the red flag. They shed crocodile-tears about

political persecution in other parts of the world and thump their chests to show how they have "exposed" the fascists in Spain, Portugal, Chile, Azania(S. Africa), Zimbabwe(Rhodesia), India, Malaya, Indonesia or Northern Ireland. But not a whimper is heard from them about the political persecution of our comrades by the British fascist state right here in London! They indulge in gossip and rumour-mongering against the Workers' Institute, failing to uphold Chairman Mao's important instruction: "Practise Marxism, and not revisionism; unite, and don't split; be open and above-board, and don't intrigue and conspire"; they ignore his advice to support whatever the enemy opposes and oppose whatever the enemy supports. A number of them are so deeply caught in the mire of legalism that without a trace of shame they vigorously defend the fascist state in Britain as still "democratic"! What is even more pernicious is that some of the so-called Marxist-Leninist circles in Britain are being harnessed by the fascist state to wave the banner of Chairman Mao to attack Chairman Mao's forces. The so-called Communist Party of England(Marxist - Leninist) or "CPE(ML)" led by the fascist agent Carol Reakes is the most concentrated example of this. Following the revisionist lines of Hardial Bains the social-fascist leader of the so-called Communist Party of Canada(Marxist-Leninist), the "CPE(ML)" gives lip-service to socialist China as the base of world revolution yet it does not acknowledge the Communist Party of China which is leading that bright red base as the Party actively leading world revolution to victory. Both Hardial Bains and Carol Reakes do not accept the authority of Chairman Mao over world revolution. They viciously attack the correct slogan: "China's Chairman is our Chairman, China's path is our path" first advanced by the great pupil of Chairman Mao, Comrade Charu Mazumdar, the leader of the Communist Party of India(Marxist-Leninist) and enshrined as the guiding slogan of the Workers' Institute. It is interesting to note in this regard that Hardial Bains himself has no qualms in posing as "the leader whose authority must be upheld" by his cronies on both sides of the Atlantic! The evil, petty-bourgeois nationalism, and the cover of "concrete conditions" are used to exert his bourgeois right to the maximum. With idealist metaphysics and ecelectics as their weapons, Hardial Bains and Carol Reakes take a pacifist posture by one-sidedly harping on the danger of world war, distorting thus the excellent stage in the world today where the people of the world led by the Communist Party of China and Chairman Mao are on the verge of capturing the imperialist and social-imperialist heartlands guided by our Party's policy of "dig tunnels deep, store grain everywhere and never seek hegemony."

Both Hardial Bains and Carol Reakes underplay the final death-throes of the imperialist economic system and using the cover of "taking a protracted attitude" they vainly attempt to give the dying superpowers and their hangers-on in Britain a new lease of life. So they merrily participate in bourgeois elections and uphold the authority of the fascist courts. It is interesting to note in this regard, that right at the time when our five comrades were denouncing the fascist courts and facing a conspiracy of silence by the bourgeois mass media, the cadres of "CPE(ML)" who uphold the authority of the fascist courts and its jury system were given wide publicity in the South London Press! (See issues of February 13th and 27th, this year). Furthermore, at the same time as our comrades were being viciously attacked by the fascist state, a leaflet of a "West Indian Defence Committee" -- a front of the discredited "CPE(ML)" -- was disseminated at our place of work in Brixton showing sudden concern for the West Indian community in Brixton! This leaflet covers up the fascist nature of the state in Britain by one-sidedly highlighting the racism practised by the fascist state. What is more revealing is that this mischievous leaflet using the cover of "attacking racism" and "showing concern" for the people in Brixton solely of West Indian origin attempts to divide the working people in Brixton on the basis of colour and race. Such a misdeed can only serve the interests of the fascist bourgeoisie! The experience of the Workers' Institute in Brixton however shows clearly that the working people of all nationalities warmly support revolutionary politics if you have respect and full faith in them as the makers of history, deeply integrate with them and patiently arm them with the proletarian revolutionary line of Chairman Mao.

It can be said with certainty that the antics of "CPE(ML)" and others who wave the banner of Chairman Mao to attack Chairman Mao's forces will come to no good end because we are living at a time when "the world is being turned upside down"!

Note: Hardial Bains, the social fascist leader of the so-called Communist Party of Canada(M-L) and whose authority "CPE(M-L)" upholds is coming to Britain this month to wave the hanner of Chairman Mao yet again to attack Chairman

Mao's forces and to boost the sagging morale of the cronies who follow him in the discredited "CPE(M-L)". An "international warrant" for his arrest in October 1970 by Interpol has yet to be implemented by the imperialist bourgeoisie. They appreciate only too well the yeoman service performed by him in misleading the revolutionary masses in the imperialist heartlands!

(2) TRADE UNIONS ARE THE DEFENSIVE WEAPONS OF THE FASCIST BOURGEOISIE!

May Day, the day of unity in struggle of the international proletariat, is being celebrated this year in unprecedentedly excellent conditions. The working and oppressed people of the world are on the offensive against the main enemies of mankind -- the two hegemonic superpowers, the United States and the Soviet Union and their hangers-on. Victory of world people's revolution and the establishment of the INTERNATIONAL DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT with the heroic People's Liberation Army of China as the main pillar and led by the great, glorious and correct Communist Party of China and beloved Chairman Mao are the order of the day. The imperialist and social-imperialist heartlands which have already been encircled by the Third World countries led by Socialist China are to be captured whether there is war or not. Only thus can the old world of colonialism, imperialism and hegemonism, propped up by NATO and WARSAW PACT, be dismantled and THE NEW WORLD of socialism and communism be built.

The panic-stricken fascist bourgeoisie in the imperialist and social-imperialist heartlands, knowing fully well that these are their last days clutch at any straw that can give them some breath. Irresistibly, they follow their logic of making trouble, failing, making trouble again, failing again, till their doom when dealing with the offensive of the working and oppressed people of the world. For example, in North America and Western Europe, they keep the people totally in the dark about the excellent revolutionary situation in the world today while rabidly preparing for war. The lie machine (press, radio, T.V., etc) is widely used for this evil purpose. The earth-shaking Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution in Socialist China, which is the continued revolution under the dictatorship of the proletariat led by the Communist Party of China and Chairman Mao to emancipate the whole of mankind guided by Chairman's instruction: "WORKING CLASS MUST EXERCISE LEADERSHIP IN EVERYTHING" is either blotted out or viciously distorted. The national democratic revolutionary movement in the Third World, expressing today with particular force in their gigantic and united struggles for a new international economic order is posing unprecedented problems for the imperialist bourgeoisie. They are no longer able with the same ease to push their death-bed crisis on to the people of the Third World as they are so accustomed to doing. Instead they have to push their burden more and more on to the shoulders of the working people in the imperialist heartlands. This has aroused the indomitable fighting spirit of the latter manifesting daily in many forms of struggle. The merging of the three movements -- the socialist revolutionary movement, the national democratic revolutionary movement and the tempestuous workers' struggles is the objective condition for the birth of the socialist new world.

It is in the light of this scientific and optimistic perspective which is of immediate significance that we can see in sharper relief the role of trade unions in the imperialist heartlands as the defensive weapon of the fascist bourgeoisie. As long ago as 1867, Marx, the beloved teacher of the international proletariat who worked closely with the English trade unions in the First International Workingmen's Association, which he led from London, denounced the deviousness of those whom he called "scoundrels" and "corrupted leaders" of the trade unions - the agents of the bourgeoisie within the working class movement. In 1871 when the Paris Commune was born, these same scoundrels led in denouncing the first dictatorship of the proletariat in world history! With the advent of the era of imperialism and proletarian revolution the use of trade unions as the defensive weapon of the bourgeoisie began to show itself more clearly. No better weapon of the fascist bourgeoisie could restrain the workers from following the path of the Great October Socialist Revolution than the trade unions tailing behind a social-fascist "Labour" Party. The betrayal of the heroic workers of Britain by the trade union system and the revisionists 50 years ago in the General Strike of May 1926 should be a sharp reminder to every progressive and Marxist-Leninist in the working class

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movement in Britain today. This needs emphasising because class struggle which is sharpening in the world and Britain is complex and there are even those who wave Chairman Mao's banner, such as the renegade and scab Reg Birch and his "Communist Party of Britain(M-L)", who are trying to rescue the trade unions from being exposed as the defensive weapons of the dictatorship of the fascist bourgeoisie. Trade unions which are instruments of class struggle can only be used today for the benefit of the working class under the dictatorship of the proletariat as Socialist China has shown.

Increasing impoverishment of the working people in Britain is giving rise to a greater desire for revolution among the poorer workers. They are breaking the shackles of the trade unions and taking to unofficial strike activities. To restrain them is a crime. Every communist is being tested today. Only by practising Marxism and upholding the authority of the Communist Party of China and Chairman Mao over world revolution and integrating deeply in working-class communities so as to arm the working people, in particular the poorer workers, with the optimistic perspective and the proletarian revolutionary line of Chairman Mao can we make a genuine contribution towards smashing the old world and in building the new. (3) "COMMUNIST PARTY OF GREAT BRITAIN" AND OTHER REVISIONIST SCUM OF WESTERN EUROPE

On May 20th, 1970, beloved Chairman Mao, the great leader of the world's people issued the solemn statement: "PEOPLE OF THE WORLD, UNITE AND DEFEAT THE U.S. AGGRESSORS AND ALL THEIR RUNNING DOGS!" In it he made a scientific summing up of contemporary history and pointed out that "revolution is the main trend in the world today" and that the imperialists are "panic-stricken at the mere rustle of leaves in the wind". Numerous facts in the last 6 years have borne out even more clearly the correctness of every word of Chairman Mao. In the same period, the great, glorious and correct Communist Party of China, using the inspiring statement of Chairman Mao as the guide, has built a powerful INTERNATIONAL UNITED FRONT of the people of the world, with the people of the Third World as the main force, against the two hegemonic superpowers, the United States and the Soviet Union. People's war raging in the Third World has scored magnificent and historic victories: Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia, Mozambique, etc., are already liberated. Unprecedented and gigantic struggles are being waged today by the countries of the Third World, fighting with increasing unity, for a new international economic order. These excellent developments have exposed and isolated the two superpowers as never before. Finding themselves in a quandary and unable to manoeuvre at will they are contending sharply with one another to gain hegemonic control of the world.

Europe is the strategic focus of the contention between the two superpowers. Both the U.S.-led NATO and the Soviet-led WARSAW PACT forces are mainly concentrated in Europe, the heart of the old world of colonialism, imperialism and hegemonism. In Britain and other parts of Western Europe the bourgeoisie have retained their control of political power on the one hand through their fascist states -- integral parts of NATO -- which perform the function of the hangman, wielding the stick at every turn, and on the other hand through their agents within the ranks of the working-class movement, in particular the revisionists, who perform the function of the priest, spreading illusions about the nature of the fascist state. The "Communist Party of Great Britain" and other revisionist parties such as the "Communist Party of France" and the "Communist Party of Italy" are past masters at deceiving the working people and betraying their fundamental interests. They are thus treasured by the fascist bourgeoisie. These revisionist parties which have thousands of members, under the guise of building "unity of the left" or "popular unity" take to the path of open class collaboration. They dampen the militancy of the working people by cultivating reliance on the sensibleness of the bourgeoisie and partaking in the bankrupt and out-dated parliamentary and trade union systems. They coordinate their activities with the lie machine of the fascist state (press, radio, T.V., etc) and prevent the working people from grasping the excellent revolutionary situation in the world today. As Lenin so succinctly observed: "The revisionists regard all reflection on 'leaps' and on the fundamental antithesis between the labour movement and the whole of the old society as mere phrasemongering. They regard reforms as a partial realization of socialism." (Differences in the European Labour Movement)

From August 1st, 1974, the comrades of the Workers' Institute of Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tsetung Thought, upholding the leadership of the Central Committee of the

Communist Party of China and Chairman Mao, have put forward the analysis of the stage in the world today. We have pointed out that we are on the verge of the victory of world people's revolution and that the establishment of the INTERNATIONAL DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT is the order of the day. For this the defeat of the two superpowers and their hangers-on is imperative. Ever since then, the two superpowers and their hangers-on have further revealed their frenzy -- the holding of the Helsinki Conference; non-stop NATO and WARSAW PACT exercises; the neo-colonial enslavement of Angola by the Soviet Union; the "Sonnenfeldt Doctrine", showing nakedly the U. S. appeasement policy towards the Soviet Union; the rabid attacks of the British fascist state against the comrades of the Workers' Institute and, the abortive incident in Tien An Men Square in Peking, stage-managed by the imperialist and social-imperialist quisling, Teng Hsiao-ping. It is against this background that one can see the revisionist parties in Western Europe, working overtime to serve the fascist bourgeoisie. These scum of the earth have, since the beginning of this year, come out one after another and with great fanfare to explicitly reject the theory of proletarian revolution and the dictatorship of the proletariat -- the essence of invincible Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tsetung Thought. Only a dying class and its agents will pit themselves in such desperation against the laws of history. However, none of the windy nonsense of the revisionists can save them or their masters because as Chairman Mao says: "the world is being turned upside down"!

(4) "INTERNATIONAL SOCIALIST" AND OTHER TROTSKYITE MISCREANTS!

Following the death of the great leader of the international proletariat, Comrade Stalin, in 1953, the Khrushchov-Brezhnev revisionist clique carried out a coup d'etat, usurped power in the Communist Party of Soviet Union(CPSU) and restored capitalism and the dictatorship of the fascist bourgeoisie in the first socialist country in the world. In 1956, at the 20th Congress of the fascist CPSU, the clown Khrushchov made a secret report -- secret only to the Soviet people -- in which under the cover of attacking the so-called personality cult, he venomously denounced Comrade Stalin, the dictatorship of the proletariat and the glorious achievements in socialist revolution and socialist construction by the heroic Soviet people under the leadership of Comrade Stalin. Ever since then, with might and main the Trotskyites aided by the imperialist and fascist bourgeoisie, have stirred up an evil counter-revolutionary and anti-communist wind in the working-class movements, particularly in the imperialist heartlands, in a vain attempt to reverse the correct verdict passed in 1937 by Comrade Stalin and the Communist International on Trotsky and his followers, that they are "a frantic and unprincipled gang of wreckers, diversionists, spies and murderers, acting on the instructions of the intelligence services" -- as it happened at that time, of the fascist axis: Germany, Italy and Japan and their backers, Anglo-U.S. imperialism. In 1963, our Party, the Communist Party of China, pointed out very correctly: "the frantic campaign against Stalin by the leadership of the CPSU enabled the Trotskyites, who had long been political corpses, to come to life again and clamour for the 'rehabilitation' of Trotsky." The traitors to the Great October Socialist Revolution, the Khrushchovite revisionists were thus joined by the miscreants who seek solace in the subjective writings, the products of the demented mind of Trotsky.

Beloved Chairman Mao, the great leader of the international proletariat today, summed up the historical experience of the dictatorship of the proletariat and of the Soviet Union and upholding the indelible achievements of the great Marxist-Leninist, Comrade Stalin, launched in 1966 the Great Proletarian Cultural Revolution to carry forward the bright red banner of the Great October Socialist Revolution. Guided by Chairman Mao's theory of continued revolution this earth-shaking political revolution has gone on for the past ten years and has brought the world to an entirely new stage -- a stage in which victory of world people's revolution and the establishment of the INTERNATIONAL DICTATORSHIP OF THE PROLETARIAT are the order of the day. This ten years have also exposed the total bankruptcy of the revisionists and their twin brothers, the trotskyites. Though they differ in words, their basic political positions as seen in practice are the same. Taking advantage of the mass movement they vie with one another to keep the fascist dictatorship of the bourgeoisie intact by spreading maximum ideological and political confusion and keeping the proletarian revolutionary line of Chairman Mao and its victorious advance in China and the world out of the consciousness of the revolutionary masses in the imperialist heartlands. They are thus promoted in a big way by the dying fascist bourgeoisie within the ranks of the workers and the student youth.

To the trotskyites -- "International Socialist"(IS), "Workers' Revolutionary Party -- the British section of the Fourth International"(WRP), the "International Marxist Group"(IMG), etc. -- the objective merging of the/^{three} great historical movements: the socialist revolutionary movement, the national democratic movement and the spontaneous mass movements in the imperialist heartlands (workers' struggles, student struggles, etc.) does not fit in with their subjective wishes. Their inveterate hatred for socialism which is the dictatorship of the proletariat is seen in their obsession with the "problems of Stalinist bureaucracy in China". Their contempt for the gigantic struggles of the countries of the Third World is seen in their continuous harping on the "backwardness of the peasantry". Though they wave the banner of "internationalism" to deceive the revolutionary masses, the actual shattering of the old world by the escalation of international class struggle led by our Party and Chairman Mao is explained away by peddling the bankrupt theories of Trotsky. This is to be expected of the agents of a dying class. The proletarian revolutionaries however are marching forward to victory along the path indicated by invincible Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tsetung Thought!

(5) BOURGEOIS AGENT, GORDON McLENNAN, DENOUNCED IN BRIXTON BY MEMBERS OF THE WORKERS' INSTITUTE!

London, April 16, 1976(S.L.W.B. Correspondent): Coordinating very closely with the British fascist state's recent wild attacks against the Workers' Institute, various agents of the bourgeoisie within the working-class movement in Britain have suddenly stepped up their activities in and around Brixton, where the comrades of the Workers' Institute are undertaking the unprecedented task of building a stable revolutionary base area. The revisionist "Communist Party of Great Britain"(CPGB) and its Secretary-General Gordon McLennan take the lead in this frenzied exercise in diversion and political swindling. For example, on April 1st, the Workers' Institute held a meeting in Central London to mark the 7th anniversary of the 9th National Congress of the Communist Party of China and to hear Comrade Ara Balakrishnan(Secretary of the Institute who was just released from the fascist jail) speak. That very day, the bourgeois agent, McLennan and his CPGB rushed to Brixton to hold a meeting to hail the 25th Congress of the fascist "Communist Party of Soviet Union"!

On the 8th of April, McLennan once again attempted to mislead the masses in Brixton by speaking there on "The British Economic Crisis - A Socialist Way Out." But this time some comrades of the Institute were there to thoroughly criticise and repudiate the revisionist lines that he spouted. Our comrades carried out a tit-for-tat struggle. They showed up his talk to be nothing but bourgeois reformist clap-trap because: (1) he covered up the source of the crisis, i.e. the imperialist nature of the British economy which imports 80% of its industrial raw materials and 50% of its food; (2) he discussed the crisis within the limits set by the bourgeoisie; (3) he ignored the earth-shaking struggles of the people of the world, in particular the people of the Third World, led by Socialist China for a new international economic order which makes this crisis the final one for imperialism; and (4) he explicitly rejected the theory of proletarian revolution and the dictatorship of the proletariat, i.e. the essence of Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tsetung Thought, and shamelessly called on the working people to confine themselves to the bankrupt trade union system and tail behind the social fascist Labour Party. He and his coterie threw up their arms in horror when our woman comrade who led this battle of annihilation forcefully reiterated the excellent stage in the world today where the people of the world led by the great, glorious and correct Communist Party of China and beloved Chairman Mao are on the verge of attacking the two superpowers, the U.S. and the Soviet Union, to usher in a socialist new world.

After the meeting some young people came forward eagerly to discuss with the comrades from the Institute. Seeing this, McLennan crept up to try to "fraternise" with us. But he made a hasty retreat from the hall when our comrades resolutely denounced him as "the scum of the earth" who owes a blood debt to the working and oppressed people of Britain and the world!
