The party was organized only in June [1920], therefore dues payments for that month comprised the sum of just \$373.90. For July dues payments of \$2,139.40 were received; for August, \$2,466.75; for September, \$3,153.15. The average number of members for these three months was 3,448. The number of members in our party has continually increased, as shown from this and as of October 7 [1920] the number of members for September [appears to] be around 4,200.
